

What's the big holiday that we identify with the month of February? Valentine's Day, of course. Feb. 14th is one of the busiest days for cards, flowers, and candy. It can also be a day of rejection and misery, depending on our point of view.

The tradition started in Rome during the 3rd century CE, with a Christian priest who was willing to marry young couples, although the emperor had outlawed it. When he was caught, he was sentenced to prison and then tortured to death. While in prison, he prayed that the daughter of the man who had sentenced him might be healed from her blindness. This act of non-romantic love gave rise to the traditions of Valentine's Day. With the wonders of modern life, we have somehow managed to turn that into a romantic incentive to spend money!

We are commanded to love God and one another in the Scriptures. In the gospel of Mark, we are told to "Love the Lord your God with all your heart." And the second commandment is this: Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no greater commandment than these." And in 1 Peter 4:8 we read, "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers a multitude of sins." Thomas Merton said, "Love is our true destiny. We do not find the meaning of life by ourselves alone - we find it with one another." This echoes John Wesley's teachings about the need to live in community with each other, to strengthen and protect and guide one another.

This month we will demonstrate our love for the shut-in members of our congregation on Sunday, Feb. 12, 2017 by caroling, visiting, and taking goodies to those members who find it difficult to attend church regularly. We will gather immediately after church to put together goodie bags and select some favorite (and familiar!) hymns to sing. After we complete the rounds, we will return to the church for a chili and soup lunch. Please join us - no special skills are required, just a heart for sharing the love of God!

Website Address


